Dear GMBC Member:

This letter is to inform you that Goodwin will be starting in person sanctuary services in the July/August 2020 time frame. Due to COVID-19, Sunday Morning Worship Services will be different from what we are accustomed. We will be sanitizing the sanctuary before each service. The wheel chair ramp entrance and the nursery will not be available at this time.

The following guidelines will be in effect while in the church building:

- We are **required** to wear mask and gloves.
- If you do not have gloves, you **must** use the hand sanitizer before entering the Sanctuary.
- Your temperature will be taken upon entering the door. **If your temperature is higher than 100.4, you will not be allowed to enter.**
- Seating will be limited (approximately 75-80 including overflow, choir stand and main sanctuary)
- Once capacity is reached the doors will be locked.
- We will practice social distancing of 6 feet or more, seating will be marked.
- We will use the Green Street Entrance **ONLY**.
- Only restrooms in the front (downstairs) of the church will be available (the Social Hall will be closed).
- **Stay home if you are sick!**

For the foreseeable future, we will refrain from walking around, hugging, shaking hands, etc. Upon entering:

- Place offerings in the cross in the foyer
- 1st Sunday: pick up your communion cup in the foyer

If you feel that you are not ready to start attending in-person sanctuary services at this time, it's okay. We will continue broadcasting service virtually. Take your time and return to church when you feel safe, do what is right for you. **You are responsible for your health!**

If you have any questions, please contact me or call the church office. We will be happy to address any concerns you may have. Until we can all be together again safely, we ask that God dispatch His Angels around you to keep you and your family safe from all hurt, harm and danger.
